The sofa buddy holds and caresses all your sofa utensils whilst also supporting your feet after a hard day

Solid beech base with turned feet. Luxurious, squidgy, soft fabric cubes.



Fire Place Tool Set Nils Holger Moormann brief



A concrete base with metal inserts to hold the tools in place.

A deep shovel that slots over the concrete block.

The Nook & Cranny brush, intuitively flips in the hand and is held like a paint brush or pen. (for tight corners)

Two piece bent construction scissor tongs, for precision and with a wide gape.

Square section steel and solid ash handles.



Home office chair John Lewis Brief



A minimal take on what's required to work at home. Multifunctional and space saving, it changes from chair to desk. Powder coated, deep olive green steel frame work with ergonomic maple seat and backrest.

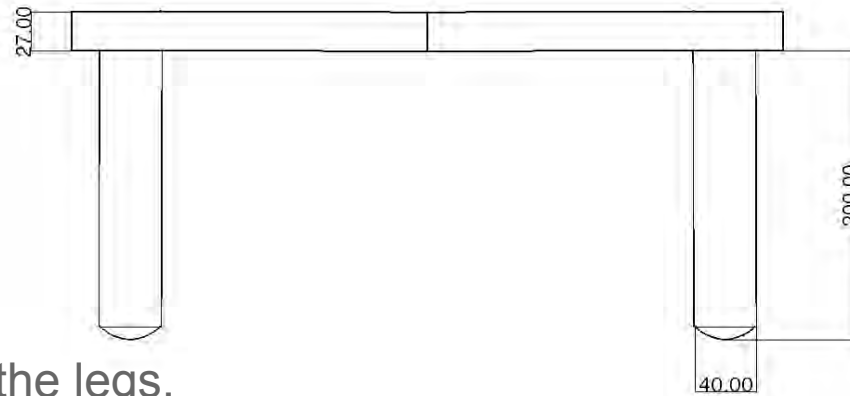
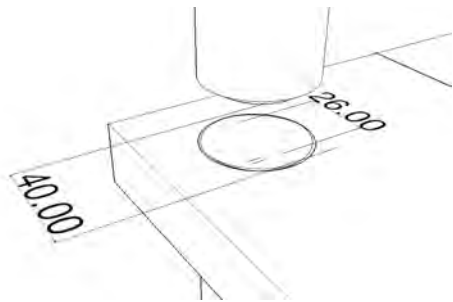
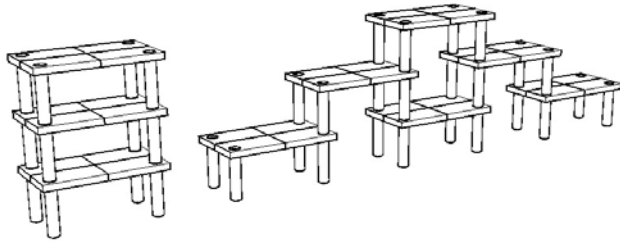
Oak Bricks

Modular stacking Oak Bricks.

Create a variety of furniture options, from shelving to side tables and low stools.



Oak Bricks



Settle holes - smooth dips - hold the legs.



The Mamluk Plate

This is my interpretation of the traditional copper Middle Eastern tray. It functions as tabletop and plate. Made from Corian, you can put food straight onto the surface. When not in use can be hung on the wall as a decorative plate by means of a solid oak rack and peg. For special occasions or just a Saturday night takeaway. Place it on your existing dining table, coffee table or even on the floor.



The Swatch Easy Chair

Inspired by a fabric swatch book, this chair uses two pieces of bent laminated ply bolted together trapping the pages of felt.

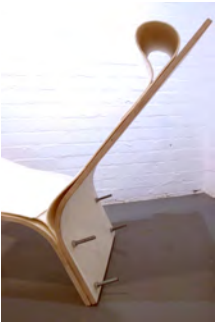
Multiple layers can be added for extra comfort or different colour schemes.

The steel under frame incorporates the front legs then tapers back to create the bolt mechanism.

Rolling the layers of felt creates more cushioning.

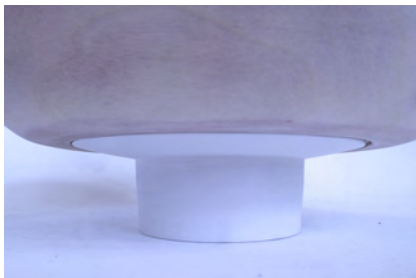


The use of four large wing nuts makes it easy to assemble and add to more layers of your choice.

Pomegranate preparation.

A celebration of this sacred fruit and its significance in human culture



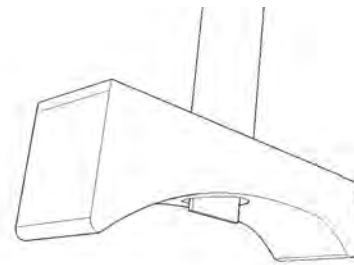
A beautifully turned wooden fruit bowl with a glazed pottery base, accompanied by a cast solid bronze pomegranate hammer.



The pomegranate hammer scores the skin, the fruit can then be halved with a simple twist.



Tap the pomegranate to release the seeds in to the bowl.



The bronze split wedge is a cutting blade and secures the handle. The hammer shape is inspired by ancient Greek bronze tools.



The seeds collect in the base, leaving a bowl of gem like fruit.

The pomegranate juice makes a wonderful natural stain.

Evolve your unique design by allowing the process to make its mark.
